During the $30^{\text {th }}$ Senate meeting held on $3^{\text {rd }}$ February 2021, the Chair of the Medals and Prizes Committee for $8^{\text {th }}$ Convocation presented an addition to the original recommended list of Medals and Prizes to the winners among the graduands. The Committee recommended to confer the 'Balasundaram Endowment Prize in German' to Mr. Hritik Gupta (B16097) in addition to the winners reported to the Board vide item no. BoG-31.2.2. The Senate recommended the name of Mr. Gupta to the Board for ratification, as per practice.

Item No.: To consider the guidelines for appointments of Honorary/ BoG-32.2.3 Visiting/Adjunct/Distinguished/Emeritus/Joint Faculty Members.

IIT Mandi has completed a decade of its establishment. Since inception, the Institute has made efforts in attracting and hiring faculty members at different levels, as required for the growth of the Institute. The Institute has adopted a very flexible hiring policy to attract senior faculty (retired or working in different institutions). Objectives of hiring such senior faculty were/are to help in teaching, administration, initiating new research areas, helping young faculty in writing research proposals for external funding and mentoring young faculty. In addition to regular faculty designations, the Institute hires such senior faculty with different designation such as Distinguished, Emeritus, Adjunct and Visiting Professors, etc. keeping in view their experience, research areas, their credentials and need of the Institute. However, it has been realized that it is often very difficult to hire such faculty primarily due to geographical location, limited medical facilities and problems associated with accessibility to Mandi. Hence, there is a need to define the perks associated with limited duration appointments and stream line the process of hiring.

In the month of December 2019, the detailed process followed by the Institute for recruitment and performance review of regular faculty was approved by the Board of Governors. On the similar
lines, this document is prepared so as to formalize the process of recruitment of Visiting faculty, Adjunct faculty, Joint faculty, Distinguished Professor and Honorary Professor, etc. This agenda summarizes the entire process with details of appointment, extension of tenure, pay, allowances and financial support for teaching and research.

The Institute Standing Committee (ISC) in it's meeting held on $12^{\text {th }}$ March, 2021 recommended the proposal to the Board (Annexure-3; Page No. 83 to 85).

Accordingly, the item is placed before the Board for consideration.

Item No.: To report the discrepancy in the terms and conditions of BoG-32.2.4 appointment of Dr. Bhaskar Mondal, Assistant Professor, School of Basic Sciences.

Dr. Bhaskar Mondal was selected as Assistant Professor Grade-I in the School of Basic Sciences by the selection committee meeting held during $12^{\text {th }}$ and $13^{\text {th }}$ September, 2019. There is an anomaly in the offer of appointment of letter reference no. IIT Mandi/Recruit./SC(SBS)2019/7501-7505 dt.18.09.2019. It has been noted that the appointment letter states that, "the post is Assistant Professor Grade-I with one year probation from the date of joining." whereas the selection committee minutes stated that the post is on "contract and to be regularized through Selection committee within three years" in remarks. The joining office order also carries this discrepancy. The board may kindly approve issuing a corrigendum as being proposed in the attached note sheet (Annexure-4; Page No. 86 to 87).

The matter is submitted to the Board for consideration.

## Item No.: To consider the proposal for creation of academic spaces for

BoG-32.2.5 Catalyst (business incubator of IIT Mandi) and Technology Innovation Hub (TIH i.e. a project of Rs. 110 Crore) by conversion of parking being constructed.

The work of construction of multilevel car parking in front side of ST01 \& ST-02 building at North Campus was approved by BoG in its $26^{\text {th }}$ BoG Meeting held on $30^{\text {th }}$ August, 2019 amounting to Rs.3,50,33,504/-. The $90 \%$ work stands completed and the likely completion date is $31^{\text {st }}$ March, 2021. This building is of three stories and covered area of each floor is as under:

Two initiatives of IIT Mandi for major outreach activities i.e. Catalyst (business incubator of IIT Mandi) and Technology Innovation Hub (TIH i.e. a project of Rs. 110 Crore) are facing a severe space crunch.

IIT Mandi Catalyst, is the first technology business incubator in Himachal Pradesh for supporting entrepreneurs which was set up in the year 2016. Catalyst has set ambitious goal of making Himachal Pradesh a world class innovation and entrepreneurship destination. During the setup, the Institute had committed a space of 11,000 sqft. Also for setting up fabrication labs on 3000 sqft area, Rs. 1 Cr . was sanctioned. Currently, the Catalyst is scattered in several different small spaces across the Institute campus.

Further, the Board in it's $30^{\text {th }}$ meeting held on $27^{\text {th }}$ August, 2020 approved the proposal for establishment of Section-8 Company for Technology Innovation Hub (TIH) in Human Computer Interaction $(\mathrm{HCl})$. The TIH is currently working from shared spaces available at IIT Mandi campus. During the project proposal agreement, the Institute has committed a space of 30,000 sqft for the purpose.

The Catalyst and TIH have committed to contribute Rs. 10 Lakhs and Rs. 15 Lakhs, respectively, for creating/renovating the infrastructure for setting-up the academic spaces as per their requirements. In addition, TIH shall also be giving IIT Mandi a rent for the space used by them.

Due to paucity of space for said activities, it is proposed to convert the big halls of ground floor and $1^{\text {st }}$ floor (equivalent area of 1280 sqm) of parking being developed in LP-1 area or for the time being for the academic space requirements and utilizations by TIH and Catalyst.

Open spaces in LP-1 area will be developed and utilized for the parking of vehicles by the residents and other users of of LP-1. If above mentioned space is provided to TIH \& Catalyst then Institute commitment would also be fulfilled and request of space would be addressed conveniently for best possible use. The conversion plan has been prepared in consultation with in-charge of these centers.

Further, there is need for setting up essential utilities/services like Banks/Post-Office/ Utility shops for day-to-day requirement of Campus residents. Accordingly, the top floor is proposed to be converted for creating these facilities as it is at a sufficient distance from Academic/residential area and shall cater to the needs of students and resident without any major disturbances to academic activities.

Estimate for conversion of parking halls into setting up of Catalyst labs/ TIH Center/essential utilities/services like Post Office/Banks/ utility shops as given below is prepared on the basis of providing light weight partition, tiles flooring, toilets facilities and electrical installation as per requirement based upon DSR 2018 and for some items on market rates as under (Annexure-5; Page no. 88 to 118).

The Building and works Committee in it's $33^{\text {rd }}$ meeting held on $19^{\text {th }}$ March, 2021 deliberated upon the proposal to convert the big halls of ground floor and $1^{\text {st }}$ floor (equivalent area of 1280 sqm) of parking being developed in LP-1 area for the academic space requirements i.e. utilizations by TIH and Catalyst, on $2^{\text {nd }}$ floor for setting up essential utilities/services like Banks/Post-Office/Utility shops for day-to-day requirement of Campus residents and recommended the proposal/estimate for approval to FC/BoG for an amount of Rs.3,52,84,042/-.

Estimates for construction works are prepared on the basis of Delhi Schedule of Rates (DSR). DSR which has been revised during the year 2018. The revised rates have almost doubled as compared to rates of DSR 2010. IIT Mandi being a growing Institute has frequent needs of urgent nature of works so a need is being felt for revision of power of various functionaries.

The Building and works Committee in it's $33^{\text {rd }}$ meeting held on $19^{\text {th }}$ March, 2021 considered the proposal and further recommended the proposal for according Administrative approval/Expenditure sanction of works by various Functionaries/Statutory Bodies of the IIT Mandi through FC to BoG for approval as detailed below:

Full powers up of Supercomputing Facility at IIT Mandi.

A 650 teraflops (TF) supercomputing facility has been approved to be established at IIT Mandi. This project is funded as a part of the national supercomputing mission (NSM) of the Department of Science and Technology (DST). The implementation of the Supercomputing facility is handled by the Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (CDAC).

As per MoU: "IIT Mandi will be sole custodian of the entire supercomputing system during and after installation and commissioning". "Sole ownership of all the assets procured/ purchased from the funds provisioned under NSM project shall vest with MeitY/DST".

- CDAC will cover (through the NSM grants) all computing equipment costs. This cost is approximated as INR 18.5 crores.
- CDAC will provide approximately INR 1.85 crores towards
the establishment cost of the supercomputing facility. The rest will have to be borne by IIT Mandi. The establishment cost includes cost for civil and electrical works along with the following: diesel generator, UPS and associated accessories, cooling equipment and heat exchangers, fire protection, false flooring, false ceiling, CCTV surveillance system, access control system, racks, water leak detection system, rodent repellent system, and building management system.

A9 classroom in the South campus has been identified as the location for setting up this facility.

As of the $16^{\text {th }}$ of March 2021, most of the equipment from ATOS has arrived on the campus and is stored in A7 GF and the thermofluids lab. The feasibility study has been completed and civil, electric and process drawings are ready.

The preparation of the first floor is completely under the scope of IIT Mandi. The ground floor room leveling has to be done by IIT Mandi along with ensuring that the necessary electrical cabling is available.

Out of NSM project part of Rs. 508 lakhs, the CDAC will be contributing Rs. 185 lakhs and work will be executed by them. The estimate document (as prepared by CDAC) is enclosed as Annexure-8; Page No. 131. The balance amount of Rs. 478.28 lakhs need to be contributed by IITMandi.

The Building and works Committee in it's $33^{\text {rd }}$ meeting held on $19^{\text {th }}$ March, 2021 deliberated upon the proposal, noted the urgency to establish Supercomputing facilities and recommended the same through FC to BoG for approval as detailed below:

1. Room preparation ground floor (Civil +Electrical) $=$ Rs. 58.79 lakhs [Annexure-6; Page No. 119 to 123].
2. Room Preparation First floor (Civil +Electrical) =Rs. 63.12 lakhs [Annexure-7; Page No. 124 to 130].
3. Existing HPC migration into A9 building =Rs. 33.37 lakhs [Annexure-9; Page No. 132 to 133].

Work at Sr. No. 1, 2 and 3 shall be carried out by the Construction Wing of IIT Mandi.

NSM Project (Estimate as prepared by CDAC) for Rs. 508 lakhs
[Annexure-8; Page No. 131] shall be carried out by CDAC. Rs. 185 lakhs shall be contributed by CDAC and balance funds shall be
arranged by IIT Mandi, and shall be deposited in installments as per progress of the work.
